

# Call for Interest – International Advisory Committee (IAC) for iADH

The IAC members represent each of the global regions of iADH in order to monitor and guide the global progress and cultural appropriateness of the organisation. Members of the IAC will be expected to advise iADH on local implementation of strategy and work together with iADH to strengthen networks for iADH in their regions and regularly share and feedback with models of good practice and local activities.

This role provides an excellent opportunity for motivated, well-networked individuals with leadership and communication skills to come together and become more involved with the iADH and strengthen and develop its relevence and usefulness across all regions of the world.

For the period 2022 – 2024, we are seeking members from the following regions:

Australasian (Australia/New Zealand/Pacific Islands etc)

South America (Brazil/Argentina/Columbia/Peru/Chile etc)

Middle East and North Africa/ MENA (Saudi Arabia/UAE/Egypt/Jordon etc)

Southern Europe (Italy/ Spain/ Portugal etc)

## **Eligibility criteria to apply for IAC:**

Candidates for the IAC must be a paid-up member and have held iADH membership for the past 3 consecutive years. iADH members applying to sit on the IAC should give evidence of activity in the following areas as appropriate:

- Active involvement in iADH activities
- Experience of executive or committee positions within regional societies
- Active membership and involvement in the activities of the iADH member association they are representing
- Participation in local, regional and/or national strategic planning activities/ advocacy roles

## Duration of term:

IAC members must be prepared to serve for a period of two years.

IAC members may stay on for a second mandate to a maximum of four years if invited by the iADH Executive. IAC members are eligible to be selected as IAC Chair after 2 years. If selected for IAC Chair after four years, the person may stay on to a maximum of six years total service on the IAC.

## Key points

The language used within the committee is English so a working knowlege of English is essential to participate. Please consider your willingness and ability to attend at least four online meetings per year (with plenty of advance notice). These meetings may occasionally be held during unsociable or work hours depending on time zones involved within an international committee structure.

## APPLICATION PROCESS:

This will include a short CV (max 2 pages); a cover letter (max 1000 words) stating your reason for interest in being on the committee and evidence of your local activities and networks, along with your current membership number and the <u>names of two current iADH members who Would support your application</u>. Please note applications are welcome from all members of the dental team including allied health and social care professionals.

All applications will be considered by the iADH Nominations committee and successful applicants will be chosen within the constraints of the number of positions available and the geographic region represented.
